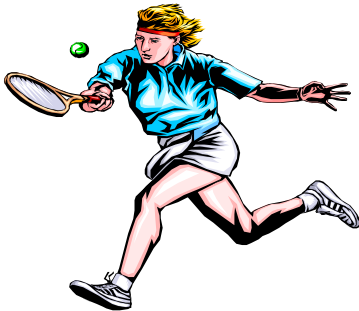

CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES:

WEDNESDAY 8TH JULY 2008

Please Note: The tournament Committee have decided that entries will be limited to the first 275 received. Entries received after this point will be placed on a reserve list.

The 18/U, 16/U & 14/U Main Draw singles events will be played on the club's 4 Impervious Acrylic Courts from the last-8 onwards, weather permitting and the 12/U & 10/U Main Draw singles events will be played on the club's 8 Porous Macadam Courts from the last-8 onwards, weather permitting

The Singles Main Draws will be staggered draws (see LTA Tournament Regulations 3.3). Depending on the entry levels for the singles events, these events may be split into Main Draws (eg. top 32 rated players – staggered draw) and 'B' Draws (remaining players – traditional draw)

Please note Alternative Scoring will apply to the 12/U and 10/U events (see Condition 10.)

Conditions

General

1. The tournament is sanctioned by the LTA and will be run in strict accordance with the ITF Rules of Tennis, the Rules of the LTA and the LTA Tournament Regulations, including the LTA Code of Conduct (as each may be amended from time to time).
2. Competitors in all singles events must be a member of the British Tennis Membership Scheme and have a BTM Rating & Membership Number.
3. Any player may be required to submit a doping control test, which may be carried out at any time with no notice given. Failure to submit to the test will be treated as if a positive result has been obtained.
4. All competitors must sign the Attendance Sheet immediately on arrival each day. Competitors must be at the ground, ready to play, when required, or they are liable to be scratched. Competitors must be available to play on the Finals' Day and are reminded that they are not permitted to play in another tournament at the same time.

Entries

5. In the interest of keeping the tournament to a reasonable size, entries to the 18/U, 16/U, 14/U, 12/U & 10/U Singles events may be limited in certain Rating categories. The Committee reserves the right to run a 'B' event if entries to the 18/U, 16/U, 14/U, 12/U & 10/U Singles events are oversubscribed and even place players on a Reserve list if necessary. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry without assigning a reason.
6. Entries to all events will close on Wednesday 8th July 2009. Entries will not be accepted unless accompanied by the appropriate entry fee.
7. Players may enter a maximum of 3 events of which no more than 2 can be singles. All singles events will include structured Consolation draws – the Consolation events are an integral part of the tournament and are not optional. For Doubles events, pairs can enter by each completing their form appropriately, or a player can enter by putting 'Partner Wanted' and the referee/organiser will endeavour to find a partner.
8. After acceptance, any player withdrawing from the tournament will forfeit their entry fee(s). Penalties may be imposed if a player withdraws either, up to 72 hours before the start of the tournament or, during the tournament. Further disciplinary action may be taken against persistent offenders. To negate any penalties, satisfactory documentary evidence must be supplied to the LTA Competitions & Tournaments Department within 14 days of withdrawal from the tournament.
9. The Draw will take place at the club on Monday 13th July. Players will be informed of the time, date (and alternative venue if necessary) of their first match by letter, soon after the Draw has been made.

The Tournament

10. All matches, apart from the 12 & Under and 10 & Under events, will be of the best of three sets, with a Tie Break operating at 6 games all in all three sets. The 12 & Under events will be the best of three sets with a Tie Break operating at 6 games all in the first two sets, with a Championship Tie Break being played instead of any third set. The 10 & Under events, apart from any Round-Robin stages, will be the best of three short sets with a Tie Break at 4 games all in the first two sets, with a Championship Tie Break being played instead of any third set and Mini Tennis Green balls will be used throughout.
11. It is intended to use Hard Courts (Impervious Acrylic & Porous Macadam) for all the Singles events and the Grass Courts will also be used for the Doubles and the Consolation events, weather permitting. It is also intended to play the quarter-finals, semi-finals and finals of i) the 18, 16 & 14 and Under Main Draw Singles events on the Impervious Acrylic courts, weather permitting and ii) the 12 & 10 and Under Main Draw Singles events on the Porous Macadam courts, weather permitting. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to use different surfaces and venues if necessary.
12. Tennis clothing can be of any colour but must be "recognised tennis clothing" i.e. no singlets or rugby shirts etc. Rubber soled shoes, without raised heels, ribbing or spikes, must be worn.
13. Competitors will be expected to call their own lines and are asked to familiarise themselves with the LTA guidelines for scoring their own matches and the LTA Code of Conduct which will be in operation at all times.
14. No complaint in connection with the tournament can be considered by the Committee, unless it is made in writing to the Tournament Secretary within 48 hours of its occurrence. No appeal against any decision of the Committee can be considered by the LTA Council, unless made in writing to the LTA within 10 days after receipt of the decision.
